Afrikan Alphabets: The Story of Writing in Afrika by Saki Mafundikwa

Task based on pages 11-48:

Divide into 4 groups and discuss the following questions in class and then answer them before the end of the period and hand in as group in-class assessment.

Group 1: Pg. 11-18 Group 2: Pg. 19-27 Group 3: Pg. 28-36 Group 4: Pg. 37-48

Once your summaries have been completed, your group will sit together and put the information into a PowerPoint or Prezi and discuss the section to your class during the following lesson.

Each group has to study the allocated section in the recommended book. As a group you will make a wise summary using the following headings:

- 1. Section of book: Indicate the group name and section prescribed as well as group members
- 2. **Topic:** If you could rename this section of the book, what would you, as a group, rename it? The new topic should capture the "essence" of what you have experienced through reading that section.
- 3. **Content:** Provide a concise but meaningful summary of no more than 5 bulleted points (in full sentences) that captures ALL the essential content so that others would understand what you read without them having to read it again.
- 4. **Message:** Reveal the MESSAGE of this section in one or 2 sentences in your own words as it relates to Afrikan Alphabets.
- 5. **Image:** Provide the name and reference to one image (in that section) that best describes what you, as a group, felt the message of that section was (above).
- 6. **Highlight:** Provide at least 1 significant highlight (surprise/ inspiration/ shock) from that section, in your own words.
- 7. Sketch. Provide a full A3 size visual/ pictorial representation of the section and its message.
